Day 2

Genesis 49	
	Jacob blesses his sons.
1.	Why does Jacob say that Reuben won't excel?
2.	Which of Jacob's sons was blessed with the promise of being like a lion and ruling over his brothers?
3.	Who did Jacob want to be buried with in the cave in the field of Machpelah?

Day 3

Genesis 50	
	Jacob is buried. Joseph and his brothers stay in Egypt and eventually Joseph dies.
1.	What did Joseph's brothers think might happen now that their father was dead and what did they do about it?
2.	What was Joseph's attitude about being sold and taken to Egypt and what was his attitude to his brothers?
3.	What did Joseph say when he was dying that God would do for them?

Exodus 1	
	The book of Exodus continues the story of the infant nation of Israel from where the book of Genesis ends. The increasing numbers of Israelites cause problems.
1.	What did the new king of Egypt fear from the children of Israel?
2.	What excuse did the midwives make for the survival of the Hebrew's baby boys?
3.	To whom did Pharaoh shift the responsibility of killing the baby boys?

Day 5

Exodus 2	
	Moses early life.
1.	How many events were involved in the sequence resulting in baby Moses being saved?
2.	How do we know that Moses, when he grew up, realised he was not an Egyptian?
3.	Why was God concerned about the plight of the children of Israel?

Day 6

Exodus 3	
	Moses learns what God wants him to do.
1.	What attracted Moses attention about the bush in which God's angel appeared?
2.	What did the LORD say he intended to do for his people?
3.	What did God say He would do when Pharaoh refused to let the people go?

Day 7

Exodus 4	
	Moses is encouraged to do what God asks him.
1.	What two signs did God give Moses to prove that He sent him?
2.	What did God say he would do to Pharaoh to stop him letting the Israelites go?
3.	Who were the first people Aaron and Moses showed the two signs to?
