	Continuing from Exodus 4 we see the development of the infant nation of Israel. We left them in slavery in Egypt.
1.	What do Moses and Aaron tell Pharaoh that God wants?
2.	What does Pharaoh command in response to Moses and Aaron's request?
3.	What does Moses say to the LORD following Pharaoh's new command?

Day 2

Exodus 6	
	God promises to deliver the Israelites from slavery.
1.	What does the LORD tell Moses that He will do to Pharaoh?
2.	What does the LORD say He will do for the Israelites?
3.	Why does Moses think that Pharaoh will not take any notice of him this time?

Day 3

Exodus 7	
	Moses and Aaron ask Pharaoh to let the Israelites go out of his land.
1.	What did the LORD say he would make Moses and Aaron seem like to Pharaoh?
2.	What did the LORD say that the Egyptians would know by the time the Israelites left Egypt?
3.	What was the difference between Aaron's rod that became a serpent, and all the rods of Pharaoh's magicians?



Day 4

Exodus 8	
	God sends three more plagues.
1.	In the second plague what places are mentioned that frogs were to be found ?
2.	What conclusion did the magicians offer Pharaoh when they could not produce lice, like God had through Moses?
3.	Why couldn't Moses and the Israelites sacrifice to God in Egypt?

Day 5

Exodus 9	
	Three more plagues, affecting only the Egyptians.
1.	What were the two specific purposes for which God said He had made Pharaoh a ruler?
2.	What did the people do who believed Moses' warning to Pharaoh about the plague of hail?
3.	Why did Moses know that Pharaoh would not let them go yet, even though he confessed that he had sinned?

Day 6

Exodus 10	
	Despite two more plagues, Pharaoh still won't listen
1.	Who did the LORD say had hardened the hearts of Pharaoh and his servants and why?
2.	What did Pharaoh's servants say to him after Moses threatened the plague of locusts?
3.	What reasons did Moses give for them needing to take all their animals with them?



Day 7

Exodus 11	
	Pharaoh still refuses to listen despite receiving a dire warning
1.	Why did the Egyptian people so willingly give the Israelites gold and silver?
2.	What did Moses say that the final plague was to be?
3.	How would the experience of the Israelites contrast with that of the Egyptians who were suffering, and why?
