



 **Introduction**

*Because the earth is filled with wickedness and violence, God decides to destroy it with a flood. Noah is told to build a ship to escape the flood.*

 **Summary Points**

- **v 1 to 4** Those whom God regards as his sons (see theme) marry those who are attractive to look at. Their children are mighty men of renown.
- **v 5 to 8** Because God sees the wickedness of men, he decides to destroy them together with other life on the earth
- **v 9 and 10** Noah is righteous and blameless and finds favour with God
- **v 11 to 22** Because the earth is corrupt and violent, God tells Noah to build a large ship to escape the flood that is coming. Noah is to take his family into the ship, together with male and female pairs of all land creatures and birds, with food for them and his family

God tells Moses to tell Pharaoh, king of Egypt that the nation of Israel is his son:

*Exodus 4 verses 22 and 23*

Moses tells the early Israelites that they are children of God because he has chosen them to be his special people:

*Deuteronomy 14 verses 1 and 2*

The New Testament tells us that God's children are those who are different from others because of their relationship with him:

*1 John 1 verse 12*

*Romans 8 verse 14*

*Philippians 2 verse 15*

*1 John 3 verses 1 and 2*
